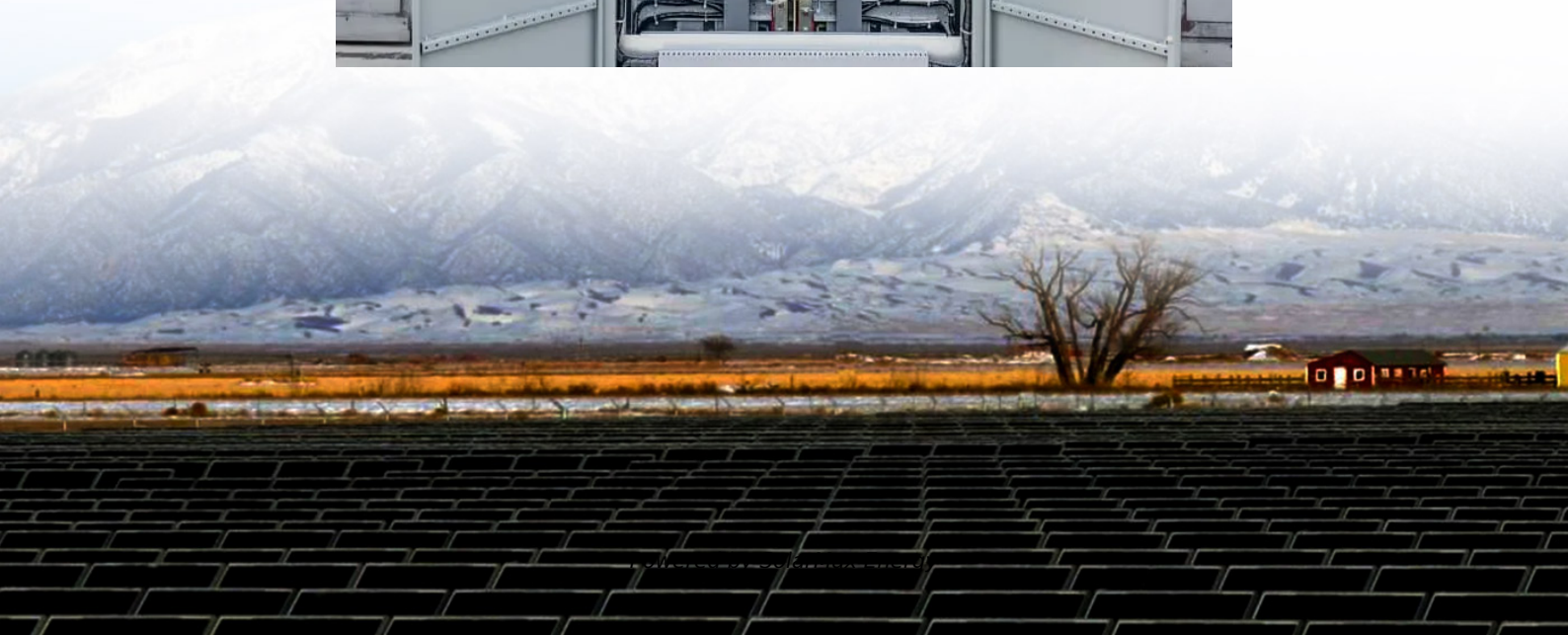


# **How does the emergency base station communicate**

How do you communicate during an emergency?

Whatever communication tools you use, be sure your emergency communications are clear, contain specific and adequate information, are in sync with other information being disseminated, and are accessible to the whole community. Indicate how day-to-day communication differs from communication during an incident.

What is an in-building emergency responder Communications Enhancement System (Erces)?

An In-Building Emergency Responder Communications Enhancement System (ERCES) is a wireless communications system used by first responder and emergency services personnel, such as police, fire, emergency medical, homeland security, and disaster response agencies.

What is a base station Radio?

Base station radios are located in fixed positions, such as public safety answering points or dispatch centers, and tend to have the most powerful transmitters. A network is required to connect the different base stations to the same communications system.

How do emergency response groups communicate?

Instead, each CERT and jurisdictional office of emergency management has its own protocols for how emergency response groups coordinate



communication. This is called a communications plan, and it defines who talks to whom.

Why is communication important in emergency response?

Communications is a key component of emergency response. Effective communications allows for effective tactical emergency response. Ineffective communications will result in poorly managed emergency response and may result in increased dangers to the responders or civilians in the emergency.

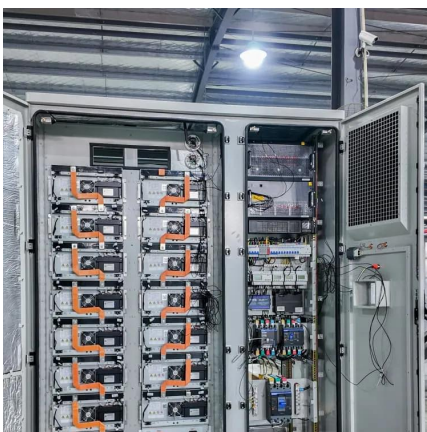

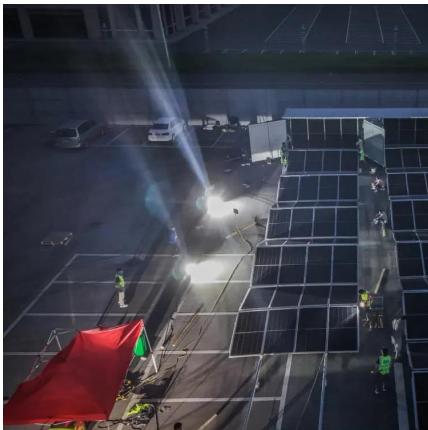

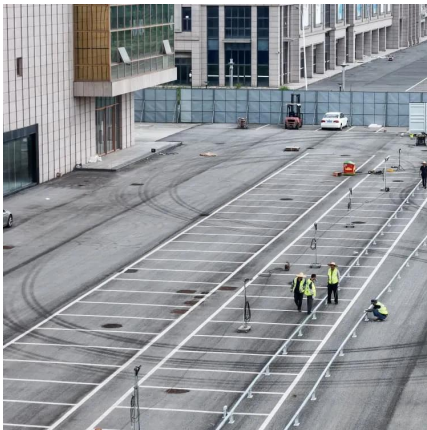
