Do I need a plug adapter if I travel to Europe?

The simplest answer is yes! You always need to purchase the correct plug adapter for the country in Europe you're traveling to. Your American device or gadget will not fit in any European electrical socket. However, as mentioned above, you must determine if all you need is a plug adapter, a power transformer or both.

Where can I buy a power adapter for Europe?

There are many different types of adapters available on Amazon that can be used in Europe. You can purchase a universal adapter that will fit most outlets in the world, or you can purchase a specific adapter for Europe. → Find travel adapters on Amazon. 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Can I use a 220 volt power supply in Europe?

Most gadgets are "dual voltage," which means they work on both American and European current. If you see a range of voltages printed on the item or its plug (such as "110-220"), you're OK in Europe. Some older appliances have a voltage switch marked 110 (US) and 220 (Europe) — switch it to 220 as you pack.

Does Switzerland need a plug adapter?

Switzerland has a wall plug that looks deceptively complicated and it appears it needs a special plug adapter. However, a regular European plug adapter with two prongs will work mostly fine if the adapter is small enough to fit. A plug adapter just like the one from above for most of Europe will work fine in Switzerland.

Do I need a universal adapter in Europe?



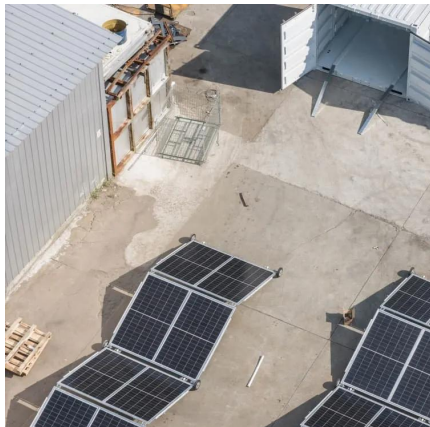
It depends on where in Europe you'll be traveling. You'll need a UK adapter to visit the UK and Ireland, and an EU adapter to visit the rest of Europe. I recommend buying a universal adapter, which will work throughout Europe. Often, universal adapters will also work in Australia and the US, among other destinations.

Do I need a voltage converter in Europe?

Some older appliances have a voltage switch marked 110 (US) and 220 (Europe) — switch it to 220 as you pack. Even older devices (and some handheld gaming systems) aren't equipped to deal with the voltage difference — you'll need a separate, bulky converter. Consider replacing your appliance instead — or doing without it in Europe.
