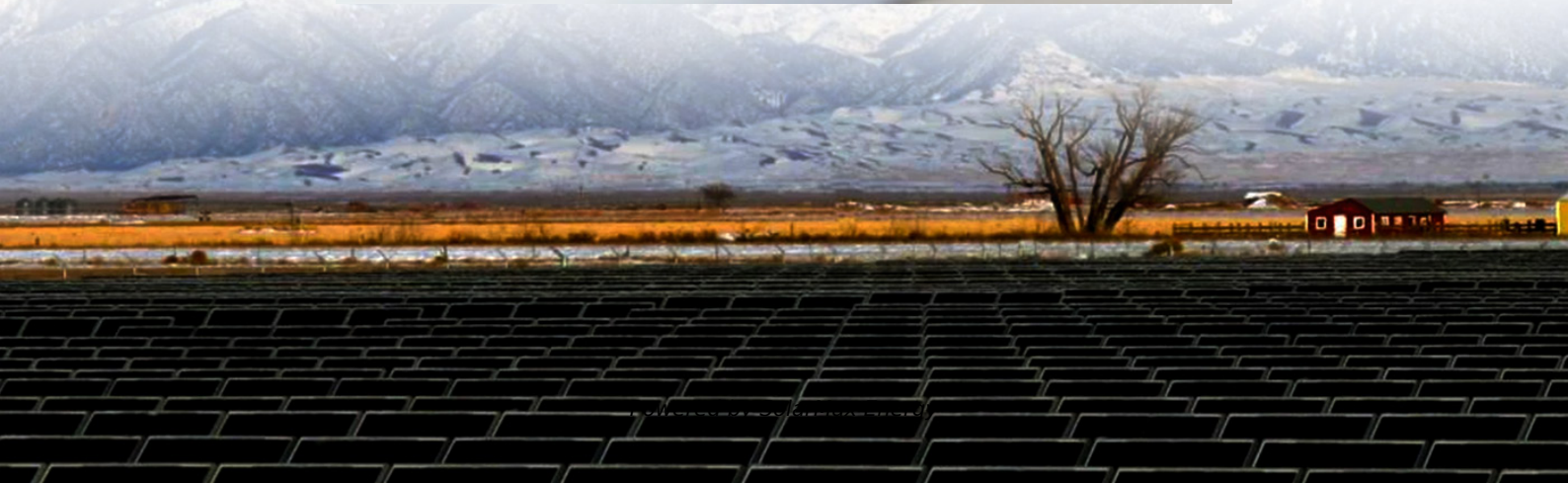


What are the base stations for Egypt's telecommunications projects





Overview

What does Telecom Egypt do?

Currently, Telecom Egypt provides the subsea industry with 10 landing stations, 10 crossing routes, and supports the landing of 14 subsea cable systems. Over several decades, the company has closely collaborated with global telecom carriers and hyperscalers, sharing a common understanding and commitment to their development and prosperity.

How will Telecom Egypt boost its international infrastructure?

Telecom Egypt is pursuing its plans to boost its international infrastructure by building new landing stations on the Mediterranean and Red seas that will be connected via new diverse terrestrial and subsea crossing routes. This has grabbed the attention of more and more global and international telecommunication players.

How many trans-Egypt crossing routes does Telecom Egypt have?

Today, Telecom Egypt owns and operates 10 diversified terrestrial Trans-Egypt crossing routes which connect all landing stations on the Red and Mediterranean Seas.

How many submarine cable landing stations are there in Egypt?

Telecom Egypt carefully selected the locations of the new landing station facilities, and accordingly built them with especially tailored specifications, and with further expansion plans in mind. There are now 10 submarine cable landing stations in Egypt, 5 on the coast of Mediterranean Sea and 5 on the coast of the Red Sea.

Egypt is the most reliable and trusted hub connecting Africa, Europe, and Asia since the early deployment of subsea telegraph cables over 150 years ago. Telecom Egypt's international strategy focuses on delivering a cutting-edge

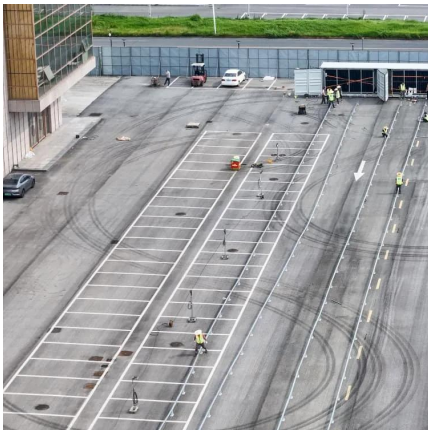

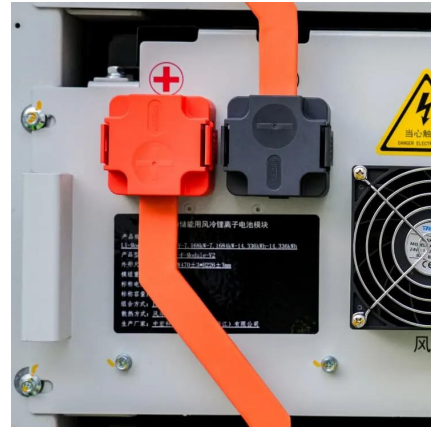

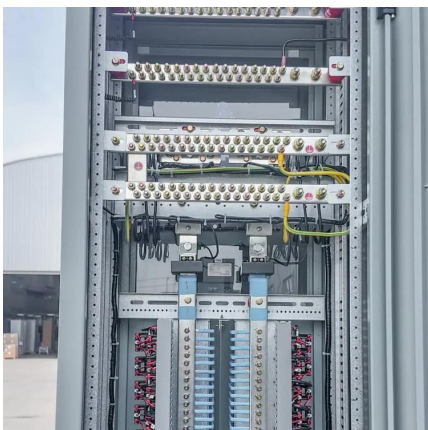
